About VoiceThread

VoiceThread is a web-based slidedeck program. Unlike others that exist, VoiceThread provides a platform for narrating your slidedeck one single slide at a time. Most importantly, VoiceThread allows the viewers of your slidedeck to comment on any slide within your deck -- using their computer keyboard, their computer microphone, their webcam, or even their cellphone. This tool bridges the gap in asynchronous learning situations, allowing for collaboration among users in different time zones and places.
